Duties and Responsibilities

- Develop a robust M&E system to capture and report high-quality, timely, valid, and verifiable data on programmatic results to the Principal Recipient (PR).
- Support the development of grant work plan, data collection tools, standard operating procedures (SOPs) and tracking progress against the set targets.
- Oversee data collection, validation, collation, storage, analysis, interpretation, visualisation, and reporting data collected in facilities and community levels.
- Conduct data analysis, writing of monthly donor reports, and review of the results and learning sections of program reports in collaboration with program staff, before submission to the PR and ensuring full compliance with the M&E data quality requirements and timely submissions of reports.
- Provide high-level M&E technical assistance on data analytics, reporting and data utilization for decision making to the district, sub-district and facility levels through mentorship and training.
- Periodically, conduct review of data collection tools and collection processes to align with the program.
- Develop an internal OSDV assessment calendar, and lead on these assessments.
- Ensure that FSRS programmatic activities both include and adhere to Global Fund monitoring and evaluation protocols and policies.
- Supervise the M&E team to ensure that all performance data as submitted by interventionists is verified and confirmed per reporting schedules.
- Ensure accurate and timely submission of reports required for periodic grant reporting.
- Periodic review of all safe-space reports for accuracy.
- Conduct monthly field supervision visits to field offices to verify reported results on weekly
 update reports.
- Management, training and supervision of the M&E Officer, M&E Coordinators and Data Quality Officers (DQOs).
- Perform any other duties as assigned by the Program Director.

- At least 3 years of progressively responsible and directly relevant experience in monitoring and evaluation of HIV prevention and response programs.
- Outstanding and effective oral communication and writing skills.
